



Spring 2025 Junior Membership Classroom Grant Award Program Fort Caspar Chapter, NSDAR

To be awarded in Summer 2025

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Two \$500 grants are available for each state and the District of Columbia.
- Applicants must be a classroom teacher for grades kindergarten through 12th grade.
- Applicants must be sponsored by a local DAR chapter and complete the grant award application.
- Proposed projects must directly benefit students in the classroom. Funds may be used for supplies and educational resources, but the applicant must detail how these items help to further the educational goals of the DAR.
- Grants must directly impact students and may not be used for continuing education/workshops for the teacher.
- **TIP:** Before completing the application, FIRST save a blank copy to your computer, then work from there. Your work can now be saved, and you can come back to it.

PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION

- Application period will begin January 15, 2025, and will end March 15, 2025.
- Submissions for Fort Caspar Chapter should be emailed to FortCasparDAR.info@gmail.com.
- Once the application period has ended (March 15, 2025), the chapter will submit their selected applicant to the State Chair. At the state level, a panel of three judges will review the applications for the state and determine a Winner and Runner-Up.
- Grant award winners will be announced by July 2025.
- Awards will be distributed no later than August 2025.
